SUBJECT: Election of CAP National Vice Commander

1. On 22-23 April 2012, the Civil Air Patrol (CAP) Board of Governors (BoG) reviewed a number of recommendations involving CAP governance processes, which will ultimately require changes to the CAP Constitution and Bylaws.
2. While these governance changes are being finalized, several of which impact the election process for the CAP National Commander and National Vice Commander, the BoG has elected to rescind Article XIV, paragraph 1b, of the CAP Constitution concerning the term of office for the National Vice Commander, as well as Section 16 of the Bylaws requiring that candidates for this position file a request for consideration 90 days prior to the general membership meeting of the National Board. The BoG is taking this action under the authority granted in paragraph 3d of Article XIX of the CAP Constitution.
3. Additionally and for the sake of continuity, the BoG has also determined that Brigadier General Joseph R. Vazquez, CAP, will remain in the position of National Vice Commander until completion of this process and approval of amendments to the CAP Constitution and Bylaws in the coming months.
