



HR-1333 FROM 110th CONGRESS



HR-1333, which was substantially revised from the original bill and passed by the House last year, must be reintroduced in the new Congress. The revised bill asks for a Government Accountability Office (GAO) study to be conducted to review the functions of the CAP and how they may support homeland security missions at the local, state and federal levels including the Department of Homeland Security. This bill is expected to result in a study with recommendations made to Congress and the Department of Defense on how CAP can be better utilized for a range of Homeland Security missions. Support from Members of Congress on the Senate and House Homeland Security Committees will be essential when the bill is reintroduced. Congressman Dent, representing Pennsylvania's 15th District, is considering that action now.
