RMR SUPPLEMENT TO CAP REGULATION 66-1

CAP AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT

SUMMARY OF CHANGES:

Updated: Checklist in AIF requirement; Lights; Emergency Water-Bottled water.

Note: Shaded areas identify new or revised material.

11-h Required equipment, Survival Kits.(Added) RMR Standardized Survival Kits are required to be carried in all RMR aircraft.

1. In compliance with CAPR 66-1 11-h, all RMR corporate airplanes will be equipped with a standardized survival kit. The survival kit will be onboard the aircraft for all flights.
2. The RMR list will not be modified locally nor can any of the RMR required items be deleted without prior permission from RMR.
3. Crewmembers are encouraged to supplement with personal items such as knives, lights, communications devices, and sleeping bags. Except for sleeping bags, a crewmember's personal survival items should fit within a day pack.
4. This is the minimum list for the RMR Survival Kits, each Wing can add items they feel appropriate for their operational concerns, and advise RMR of additional items that were added for future reference.
5. Survival kit checklist will be required to be filled out initially and inserted in each kit. A quarterly inspection and a new checklist will be filled out and put in the kit or if any items meet their expiration date prior to the quarterly inspection or any items have been used, which ever is sooner. **An additional copy of the survival kit checklist shall be put in the aircraft AIF, under Tab #2 for easier reference.**
