CAP EMERGENCY SERVICES TRAINING AND OPERATIONAL MISSIONS

CAPR 60-3, dated 17 August 2009, is supplemented as follows:

2-2.a.(1). Qualified Supervisors, and the specialties they are authorized to certify, must be identified in writing and approved by the Unit, Group, and Wing Commander. Pending completion of the SET approval process in E-Services, the Texas Emergency Services Evaluator List shall be used to designate qualified supervisors and evaluators.

2-2.d. Subsequent CAP Forms 101 (renewals) will be approved at the wing level.

2-4.b.(2). ES Evaluators will document renewal evaluations on a Specialty Qualification Training Record (SQTR) for the applicable specialty. Record evaluator name, CAPID, date, and mission number. The evaluator will sign the SQTR, provide a copy to the member for their individual CAPF 114 record, and forward a copy to DOS. DOS will record the renewal of the specialty in E-Services Operations Qualifications.
