**Operations**

**FLIGHTS OUTSIDE OF VAWG**

---

CAPR 60-1, dated 5 January 2009, is supplemented as follows:

**2.2c.:** Permission is granted to operate any Virginia Wing aircraft to and from any wing within the Middle East Region, and any wing in another region that adjoins Virginia Wing, provided the aircraft returns on the same day.

If the pilot and aircraft, or the aircraft alone, needs to stay overnight in another wing, written permission from the VAWG/CC is required (may be verbally approved by the VAWG/CC with a written follow-up within 5 calendar days). Such written requests must include the reason for the flight, why it must remain overnight in another wing, where the aircraft will be based in the other wing, and its estimated time of return to VAWG. Any expense involved in this "overnight" shall be addressed in accordance with VAWG financial procedures.
