Congratulations on your selection to attend the 2009 Cadet Officer School. Your decision to apply, and your subsequent selection by your local wing, has put you on the path to becoming a better Cadet Officer.

You will face many new challenges at the school and your preparations begin now. To confirm your acceptance you must go online and pay the activity fee of \$280 not later than 15 April 2009. If you decide not to attend please let National Headquarters know as soon as possible so we can offer an opportunity to another cadet to attend.

This year's school will be held from 13 July to 23 July at the Air University facilities located at Maxwell Air Force Base. If you live more than 250 miles away from Montgomery, Alabama arrangements will be made for you to fly from the closest airport where you live to Montgomery and back home. You must notify National Headquarters of the closest airport to your residence not later than May 2, so the appropriate airline reservations can be made. If you live within the 250-mile boundary, you will be reimbursed per mile for traveling in your personally owned vehicle.
